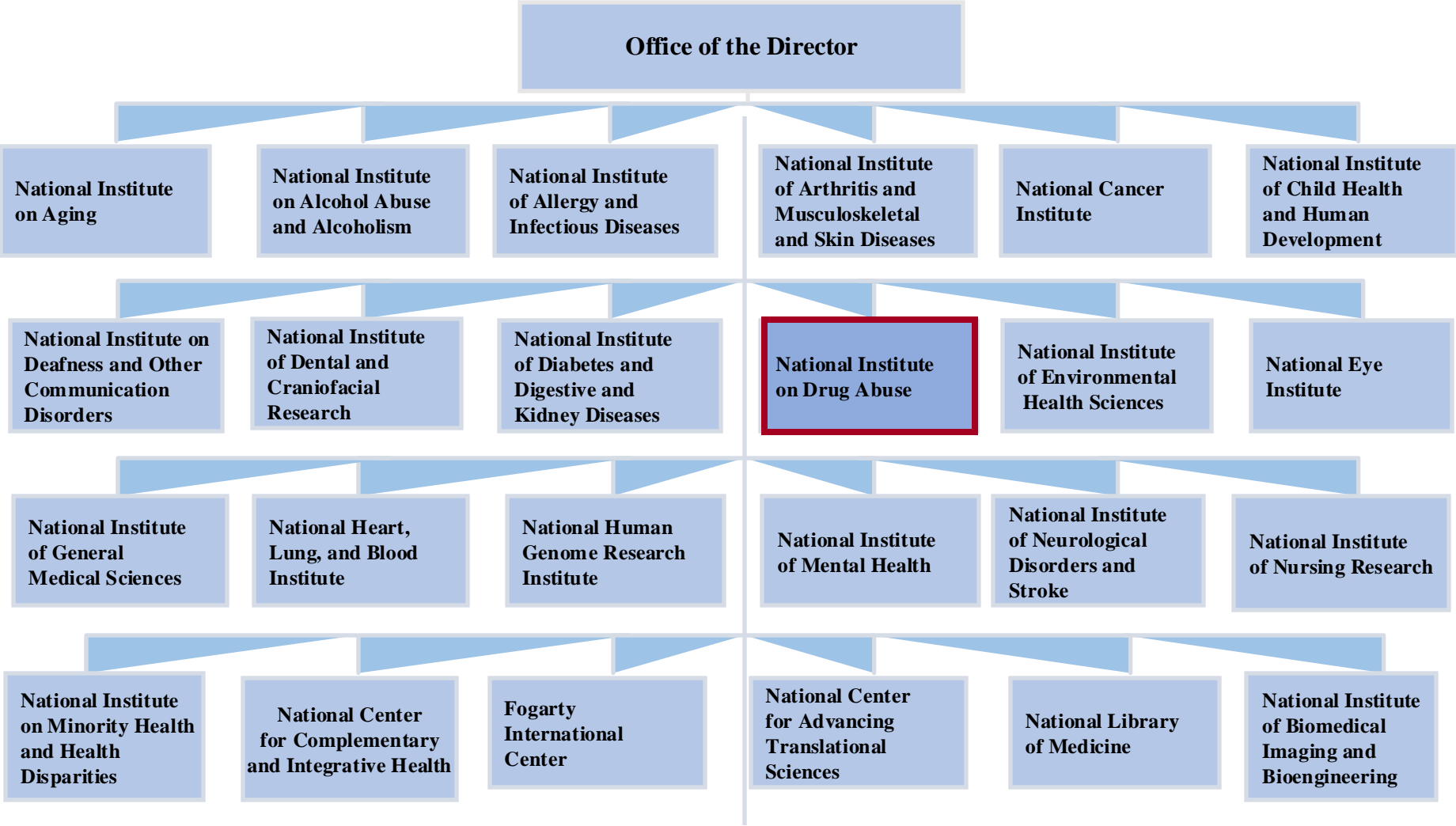
The mission of the NIH is to seek fundamental knowledge about the nature and behavior of living systems and the application of that knowledge to enhance health, lengthen life and reduce illness.

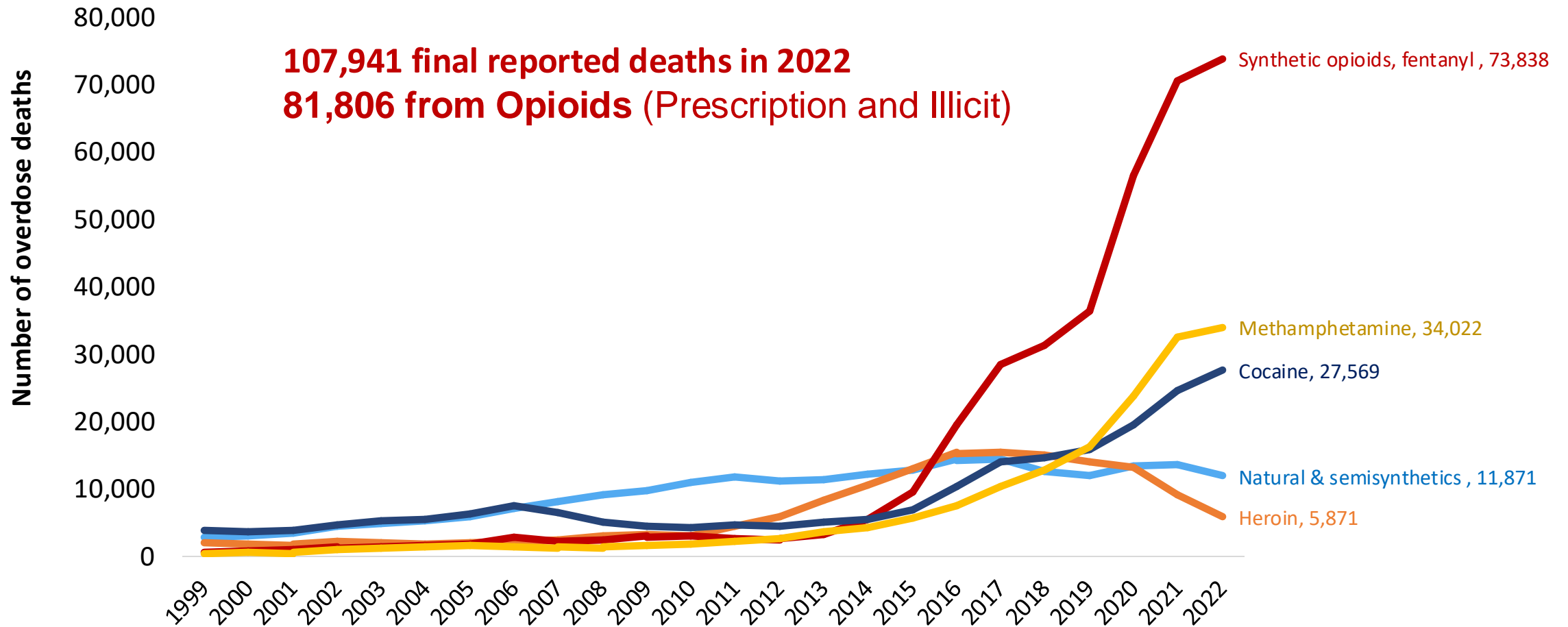


FY 2022-2026 NIDA Strategic Plan

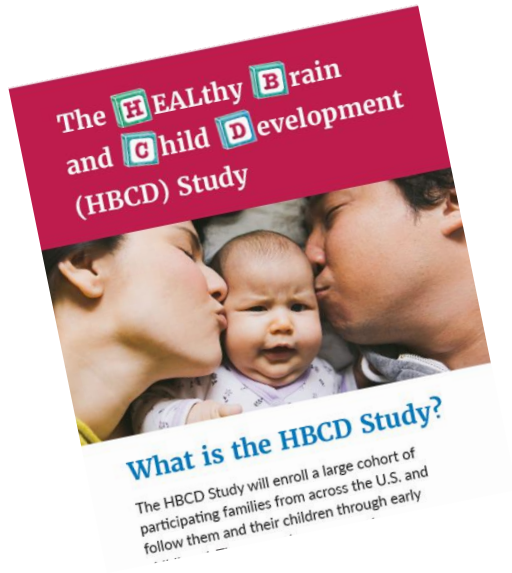
NIH Helping to End Addiction Long-term (HEAL) Initiative

An NIH-wide effort to speed scientific solutions to the opioid public health crisis

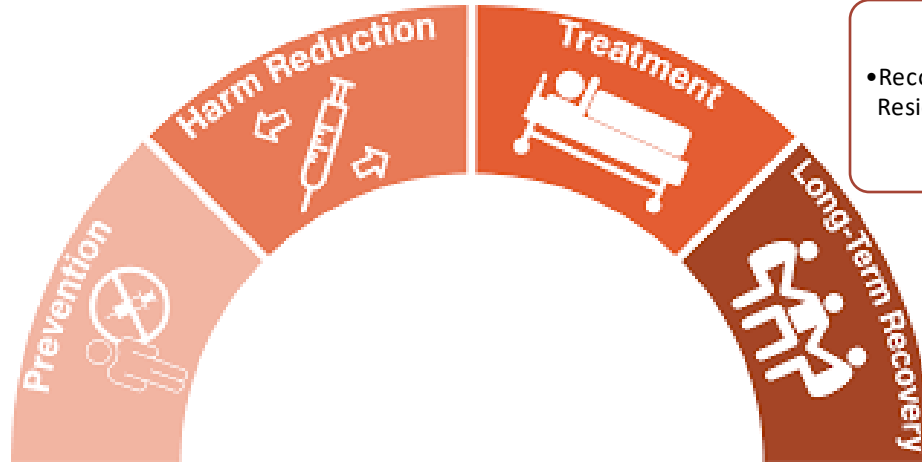
- Led by NIDA and NINDS with collaboration across 18 NIH Institutes and Centers
- Since 2018, >1,800 HEAL awards have been funded in all 50 states
- >40 FDA investigational new drugs or devices
- 300+ clinical trials under way
- Active ongoing partnerships with communities, federal, state, and local agencies, private sector companies, and academia



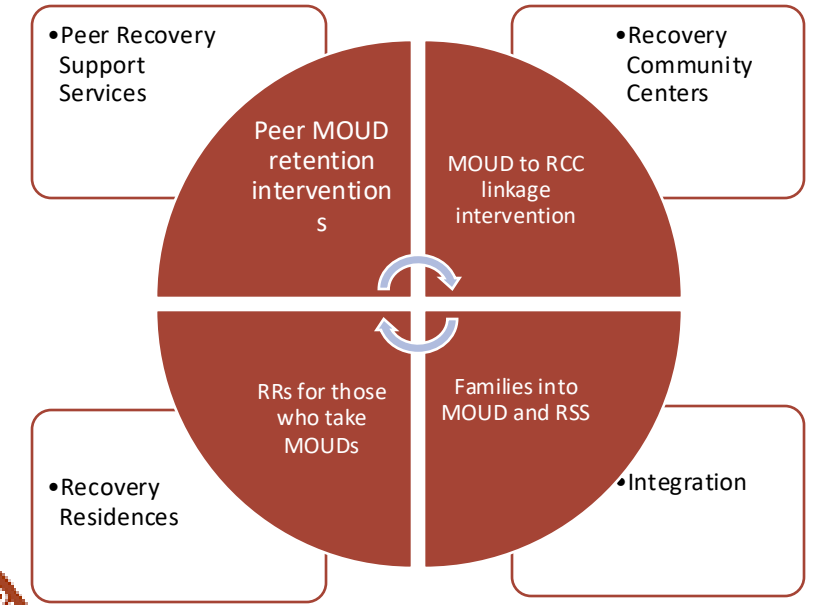
Research Across the Cascade of Care for Substance Use Disorder

Longitudinal (n=7,500 infants) normative neurodevelopment study from birth to 9-10 years to investigate impact of drug exposures and social determinants of health factors and genes throughout childhood

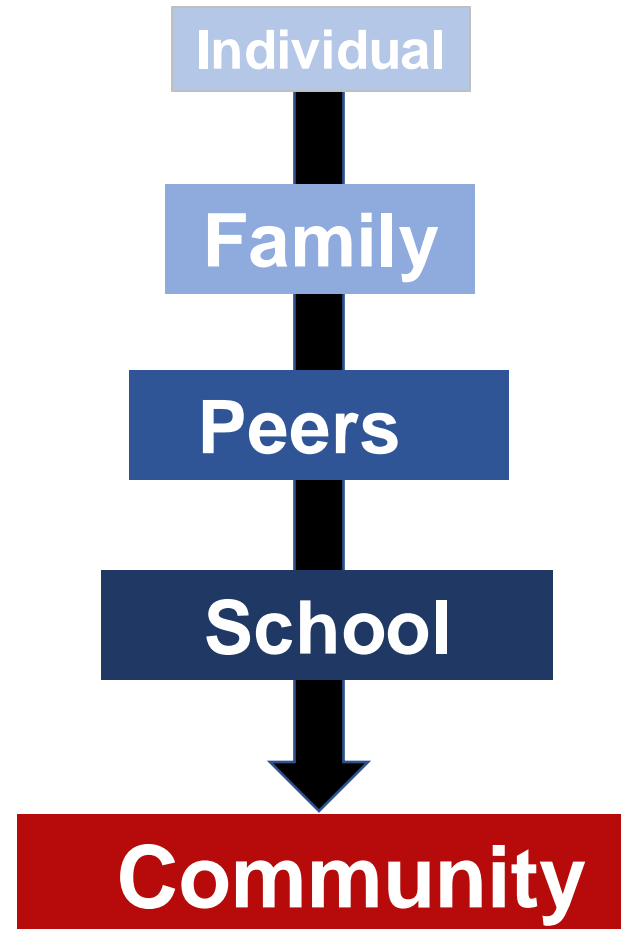

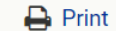

INVEST Postdoctoral Fellowship

- Rigorous 12-month Postdoctoral **research training** with a NIDA grantee at a U.S. institution
- **Professional development activities** that help establish personal relationships with NIDA grantees and NIDA officials
- **Mentors** must be NIDA-funded researchers
- **Eligibility**
 - International researchers with a doctoral degree
 - A minimum of 2 years postdoctoral experience
 - English proficiency
- **Application Review Criteria**
 - Applicant expertise
 - Research strategy
- **Applications Due Date:** October 1 2024



NIDA Humphrey Fellowship

- **Hubert H. Humphrey Fellows (1990 – present)**

- International research and exchange collaborations contribute to advances in scientific understanding about drug abuse and addiction
- Mid-Career Fellowship
- 383 fellows from 101 countries (about 12/year)

- **Research**

- 10 months substance use research fellowship at Virginia Commonwealth University (Richmond, Virginia, USA)

- **Professional Affiliations (last 6 weeks of fellowship)**

- Goal is to make connections to advance their ongoing work

Distinguished International Scientist Collaboration Awards (DISCA)

- International senior researchers and NIDA-funded senior researchers apply to collaborate
- Applicants must propose an innovative collaboration that can produce outcomes—such as a new investigative finding, scientific publication, or research grant proposal
- Awardees receive stipend (up to \$8,000 USD) to support exchange
- Applications are open now

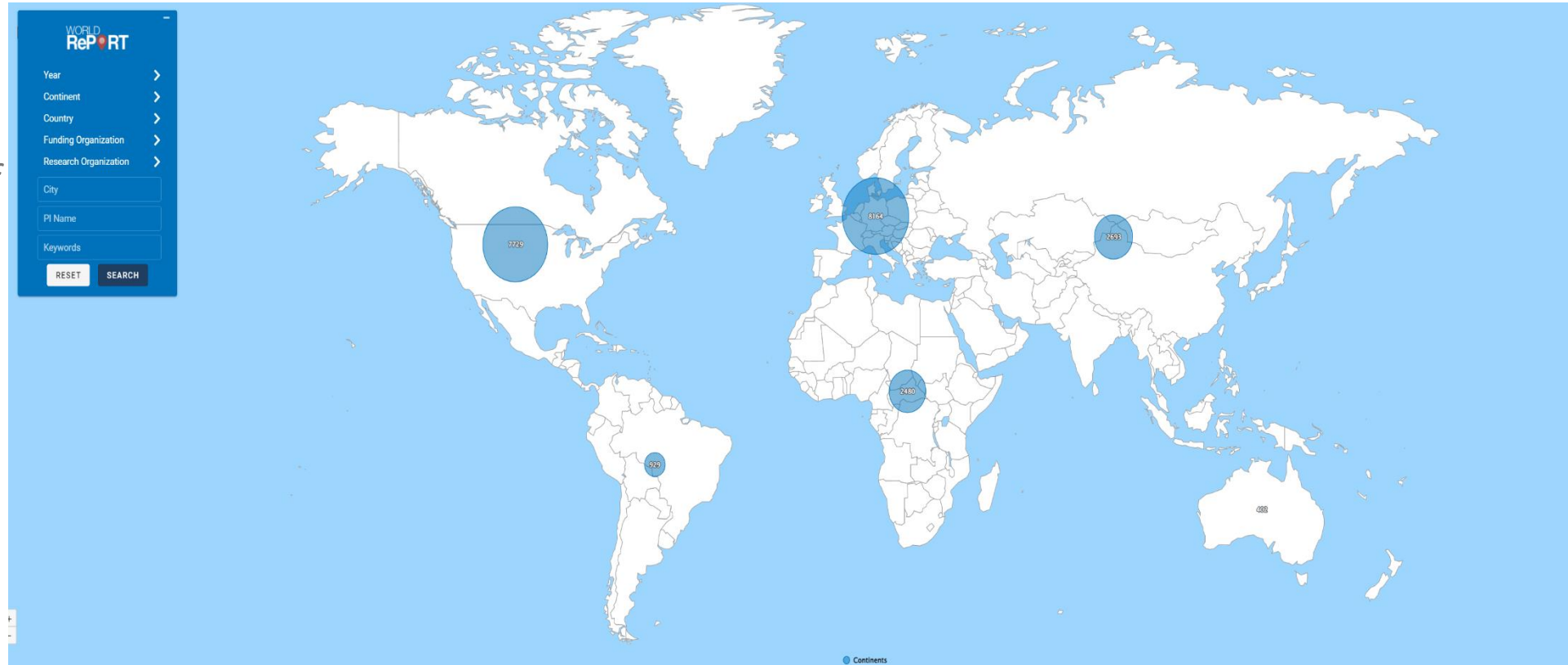

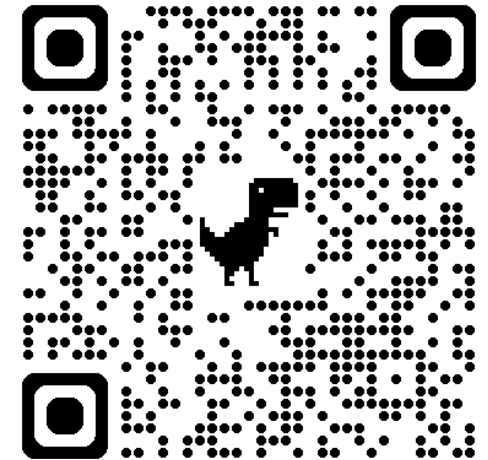
